Early Intervention/Treatment Program

A core Rainbow Program that includes a comprehensive, individualized service model providing assessment/evaluation, referral, advocacy, interagency coordination, play therapy, parent education, individual, family therapy, in-home services, consultation in daycare, schools, foster homes.

Children of Violent Homes Prevention Program

Rainbow collaboration with Domestic Abuse Intervention Services, Briarpatch and Family Service to provide services, across ages and needs, for children and youth, who have witnessed domestic violence.

PRIDE Preschool Program

Rainbow Project therapists partnering with early childhood educators and child care providers offering in-depth training, support and consultation for selected city certified centers. The purpose of this special program is to help prevent future, more serious problems from occurring with the children and families they serve.

Mothering Beyond Fear and Sadness Group

A special group for mom's with mood disorders, including depression and anxiety. The group meets ongoing, monthly. Child care and dinner are provided.

F.A.C.E. Groups for Children and Youth

A multi agency collaboration to provide groups for children and youth in Dane County. Rainbow's Sassafras Girls group and HIGH FIVE Boys group (8- week group series) focuses on building positive social skills, self-esteem, anger and stress management, problem solving skills and affective development and School-age Parent Groups are held in the community, schools, child care settings and at the Rainbow clinic.

Grandparents Raising Their Grandchildren

Monthly support and education group, warm-line phone resource, monthly newsletter, child development and management resources for grandparents who are primary caregivers for their grandchildren.

SAFE STEP Program

Rainbow collaboration with SAFE Harbor, Mental Health Center of Dane Co., Oasis Project to provide a prompt trauma assessment and support for a child and non-abusing parent following a Safe Harbor forensic interview for child abuse, child sexual abuse, neglect or domestic violence.
