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A. Legislative File # 01853: The CPD obtained a 30-day extension from the bill's sponsor in order to review the ordinance. The Commission discussed acknowledging the receipt of this request, placing it on the October agenda for action and referring the proposal to the EOC for comment by the October CPD meeting. The Commission also asked for a report from the City Attorney's office regarding the legal issues involved in the proposed ordinance by the October CPD meeting.

Jessie Kaysen, a private citizen, addressed the Commission. She submitted a four-page document that had been reviewed by Attorney Jodi Hanna from the Wisconsin Coalition for Advocacy and that contained concerns about the impact of the proposed ordinance. The Commission referred the document to the EOC and to the City Attorney's office to consider when preparing its report.

Ms. Kaysen stated that, although the drafter of this legislation claims this is a technical revision limited to modernizing language, in some cases there may be changes in the meaning of the affected ordinances, with important policy considerations. These policy considerations should be addressed as each ordinance comes up to be changed. She wanted the CPD to carefully and deliberately review each ordinance affected by the proposed ordinance. She also asked that the CPD support maintaining the sometimes more expansive standards than the ADA currently allowed in Madison city ordinances for civil rights for people with disabilities.
